EXPENDITURES

The expenditures increased \$221.15, the principal items being taxes \$40.61, landlocking \$160.00, and forest protection \$20.54. The item of landlocking was on account of examining all the company's lands to enable the making of a complete report covering the timber and soil value of the property. The forest protection was on account of the assessment of the Northern Forest Protective Association. This service will be discontinued for the year 1914.
